## **Shape Sorter Game Score Card**

The **rules** of Shape Sorter Game are:

- Make sure your computer is set to MAKE THE RULE.
- The score card below tells you which version of the game to use in each round of the game. For example, in the first round, you use the one-rule / one-circle version of the game.
- In Player 1's turn, Player 2 chooses (or makes) the rules for the circle or circles.
- Player 1 then moves objects into various areas on the Venn diagram. Don't try to move objects into the area outside the circles.
- Player 2 keeps track of how many right and wrong guesses Player 1 makes.
- If there are 2 players, then Player 1 sets the rules and keeps score while Player 2 moves objects into the areas of the Venn diagram. If there are 3 players, Player 3 should set the rules and keep score for Player 2.
- At the end of the game, a player's score is the total number of right answers minus the number of wrong answers. The player with the highest score wins.
